AS AN EXPECTING PARENT WORKING WITH US, YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO :

- Confidentiality.
- Be able to make decisions free from coercion or pressure.
- Seek legal counsel if you choose.
- Request help with reasonable pregnancy -related expenses permitted by law.
- Work with social service agencies as you consider an adoption plan.
- Receive counseling from an agency of your choice during and after your pregnancy.
- Create a birth plan that can include time with your baby in the hospital.
- Review all documents for the adoption prior to signing and receive copies of all signed documents.
- Understand Indiana adoption registries.

AS AN EXPECTING PARENT WORKING WITH US, WE ASK THAT YOU :

- Work cooperatively and honestly with our Staff.
- Voluntarily provide all known medical, background, and family information about yourself and your immediate family.
- Provide proof of pregnancy prior to receiving financial assistance.
